2016-2017 ABMS Visiting Scholars Program Application

Background and Purpose

The American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS) Visiting Scholars Program is a one-year, part-time program that provides exposure to the fields of professional assessment and education, regulatory policy, and quality improvement (QI) while promoting research and scholarship in areas related to Board Certification and Maintenance of Certification (MOC)/Continuing Certification (CC) that are important to the ABMS Member Boards Community.

Program Goals

- Scholars will refine their research skills and scholarship, in collaboration with their institutional mentors and ABMS, by engaging in a research project about Board Certification and MOC/CC
- Scholars will contribute to innovations in continuing professional development (CPD), assessment, quality improvement (QI), and/or health policy
- Scholars will become familiar with health policy and the external environment in which continuous certification occurs
- Scholars will have an opportunity engage with the ABMS Member Boards
 Community and other leading health care organizations

Eligibility

The program is open to early career physicians and junior faculty including assistant professors and instructors, fellows, residents, medical students, public health students, graduate students and PhDs in health services research and other relevant disciplines.

Award

Scholars will be awarded \$12,500 to support their research and travel for this

program, which will begin in August 2016.

Program Requirements

- Scholars will participate in three 3-day, in-person programs during the year to occur primarily in Chicago
- Scholars will participate in monthly videoconferences and in-person meetings with health care and Member Board Community leaders
- Scholars will meet with institutional mentors and ABMS leaders to further develop and refine research projects and plans
- Scholars will provide feedback in a timely manner of their experience with the elements of the program

Research Project

Under the guidance of a mentor at the scholars' current institution and ABMS leadership, scholars will further develop, refine, and conduct research relevant to and aligned with interests of the ABMS Member Boards Community. At the end of the year-long program, scholars are expected to disseminate their work, either at an ABMS conference or other national meeting, and/or by submitting a paper for publication to a peer-reviewed journal within 12 months of completion of the Scholar year. Preference will be given to applicants who submit a research plan and timeline that is likely, in the judgment of the selection committee, to be ready for manuscript submission within this time frame.

Application

The Visiting Scholars Program is highly competitive; a well-prepared application and carefully selected letters of recommendation are key components to a successful application.
