SUBJECT: Candidates for Program Director of the San Antonio Uniformed Services Health Education Consortium Pathology (PATH) Residency Program

- 1. In accordance with San Antonio Uniformed Services Health Education Consortium (SAUSHEC) bylaws, I am pleased to announce to the three military medical services a search for a new program director (PD) for the SAUSHEC Pathology (PATH) Residency Program.
- 2. We request this position be announced to interested pathology physicians with requisite specialty expertise and documented educational and administrative experience acceptable to the Accreditation Council of Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) Pathology Residency Review Committee (RRC). Per the RRC, Applicants must have current certification in the subspecialty by the American Board of Pathology (ABIM); or specialty qualifications that are acceptable to the RRC. Applicants must have a current certification in anatomic and/or clinical pathology. The program director must have five years of participation as an active faculty member in an ACGME- accredited pathology residency program or a pathology residency located in Canada and accredited by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC). Exceptions to these requirements will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- 3. Selectee must be available to be assigned to Navy Medicine Training Support Center, JBSA Ft. Sam Houston, TX by Fall 2018 (exceptions to the report date will be individually considered.)
- 4. Please submit electronic applications of qualified candidates, with your endorsement, to SAUSHEC Institutional Coordinator Mrs. Jeri Garrison not later than 10 September 2018. Each candidate's package should include:
 - a. Curriculum vitae (with email address and contact phone number)
 - b. Statement of desire and commitment
 - c. Current copy of Officer Data Card
 - d. Two letters of recommendation, one of which is from the candidate's immediate supervisor.
 - e. A list of three additional references (with email addresses)
- 5. Applications will be reviewed by a Selection Committee and the final selectee will be approved by the SAUSHEC Command Council.
