ONLINE APPLICATION GUIDANCE

- **To Access** the online site, first request a Single Sign On (SSO) account <https://apps.usuhs.edu/account-registration/>
 - If you receive an error message – e-mail sakaihelp@usuhs.edu.
- Fellows in GME training may apply for Instructor appointments, and staff physicians for Assistant Professor.
- Staff physicians with prior faculty appointments from other institutions should discuss their USU appointment with the department
