Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this fund drive is being extended to 30 June 2020.

All Navy and Marine Corps personnel requiring a Special Duty Medical Examination for dive, flight, landing craft air cushion, naval special warfare and special operations, nuclear field duty, radiation, and submarine duty status in the months of March 2020 through June 2020 are authorized an extension of four months from date of current exam expiration.

Anticipate modifications to this policy over the next several weeks as additional information becomes available.

This NAVADMIN is issued pending OSD and DON policy still in development. Upon release of the OSD and DON guidance, this NAVADMIN will be modified accordingly.
100/20	<a href="#">NAVY GUIDANCE ON THE USE OF FACE COVERINGS</a>	4/05/2020	All individuals on DoD property, installations, and facilities are required to wear a cloth face covering when they cannot maintain 6 feet of social distance.

If unable to schedule an appointment, customers will be serviced via a controlled walk-in process for CAC PIN resets only.
093/20	<a href="#">COMMERCIAL VIRTUAL REMOTE (CVR) COLLABORATION ENVIRONMENT (CORRECTED COPY)</a>	3/27/2020	The DoD Commercial Virtual Remote (CVR) is a limited/temporary DoD-only instance of Microsoft Teams and OneDrive for Business (ODfB), a communication and collaboration, cloud-based platform integrated with Microsoft Office 365.
092/20	<a href="#">URINALYSIS POLICY UPDATE</a>	3/27/2020	Commands will continue random urinalysis specimen collection from Sailors during the COVID-19 pandemic to the greatest extent possible. Commanders and Commanding Officers may pause collection and/or reduce collection percentages and numbers of days collected if he/she deems it necessary to support maximum operational flexibility and/or COVID-19 mitigation efforts.
089/20	<a href="#">VOLUNTARY EXTENSIONS FOR ACTIVE COMPONENT NAVY MEMBERS WITH APPROVED SEPARATION OR RETIREMENT DATES</a>	3/26/2020	The Navy is accepting applications from officers and enlisted personnel who desire to delay their separation or retirement. Service members with an approved separation or retirement date before 1 April 2021 are eligible to submit a request to their detailer to have their separation or retirement date delayed between 6 and 12 months. Requests must be received by 1 July 2020.
083/20	<a href="#">RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT (ROM) GUIDANCE</a>	3/23/2020	This NAVADMIN clarifies the definition of "Restriction of Movement" (ROM), provides amplifying guidance, and delineates responsibilities for execution of ROM.
082/20	<a href="#">NAVY TRANSITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM POLICY UPDATE FOR COVID-19</a>	3/23/2020	This NAVADMIN announces the immediate suspension of all Navy Transition Assistance Program (TAP) in-person classes until further notice. Service Members with upcoming separation dates, who are unable to reschedule TAP attendance for a later date, must complete TAP via Joint Knowledge Online (JKO).
080/20	<a href="#">NAVY MITIGATION MEASURES IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK UPDATE 3</a>	3/21/2020	This NAVADMIN supersedes 3 previous NAVADMINs (064/20; 065/20; and 074/20) and consolidates those NAVADMINs into one NAVADMIN for ease of reference.
074/20	<a href="#">NAVY MITIGATION MEASURES IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK UPDATE 2</a>	3/19/2020	This NAVADMIN supersedes 2 NAVADMINs (064/20 and 065/20) and provides additional information concerning Permanent Change of Station (PCS) of Navy civilians, travel for official training, personal leave for Navy civilians, delegation of exception authority and regular reporting requirements.
073/20	<a href="#">TEMPORARY RELAXATION OF HAIR GROOMING STANDARDS IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK</a>	3/18/2020	Commanding Officers are authorized to relax the Navy hair length grooming standards for Sailors assigned to their command. Relaxed hair length grooming standards will only apply to the area of the scalp. Policy guidance regarding sideburns, hair styles and shaving requirements remains in effect.

All personnel will be excused from participation in Cycle 1, 2020, including those who have already completed the PFA.
<b>068/20</b>	<a href="#">EFFECTIVE USE OF REMOTE WORK OPTIONS</a>	<b>3/17/2020</b>	This NAVADMIN provided guidance for shore commands using Navy and Marine Corps Intranet (NMCI) and ONE-NET, describing the capacity of remote work resources and the priority in which they should be leveraged.

It summarizes and repeats applicable guidance where appropriate so that this will serve as a one-stop information source.
<b>058/20</b>	<a href="#">UPDATED GUIDANCE DURING THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK</a>	<b>3/05/2020</b>	This NAVADMIN directs the submission of a daily report for all Navy component commands (via email) to the OPNAV Navy Operations Center/Battle Watch Captain NLT 1700 Zulu daily until complete. Negative reports are required.
<b>039/20</b>	<a href="#">UPDATED DOD GUIDANCE FOR MONITORING PERSONNEL RETURNING FROM CHINA DURING THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK</a>	<b>2/11/2020</b>	This NAVADMIN directed all Navy commands to identify all servicemembers returning from mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau after 2 Feb 2020. Commands will place these servicemembers under a 14 day Restriction of Movement (ROM).
