

Highlights from the Navy Medicine Clinical Communities

Each Clinical Community (CC) consists of an Advisory Board (AB), Sub-Communities (SCs), &/or Working Groups (WGs) focused on specific objectives. This section highlights recent key developments in each CC:



The Mental Health SC stood up a Cultural Competency Training WG to develop training and educational materials for promoting effective communication, cultural sensitivity, and professionalism. The WG is currently drafting the first five sections of the training.



The Psychological Health CC voted to include the Type Command (TYCOM) Force Mental Health officers as ad-hoc non-voting members of the Psychological Health AB to increase the community's focus on the readiness mission. The Mind Body Medicine SC is refreshing membership, priorities, and initiatives.



The Dental Services CC is currently routing three products for vote including: High-Level Disinfection/Sterilization SC Statement on Single Use Items, Personnel Qualification Standard for Sterile Processing Department (SPD) staff, and SPD "Receiving, Handling, and Decontamination of Instruments" Standard Operating Procedure.



The Equipment Safety and Standardization SC put forward a paper on Cold Compression Therapy to the CCB for vote, distributed the final version of the Hydrocollator & Hot Pack paper, and is developing a paper on Blood Flow Restriction Therapy.

The Operational Medicine CC is finalizing the recommendations from the Maritime Blood Strategy WG. The Operational Forces Medical Liaison (OFML) SC is compiling information to create a shared mission and understanding of OFML functions.

The Trauma CC and interim Trauma Advisory Board (TAB) Chair co-hosted a virtual summit to refresh the goals and objectives of Navy Medicine's Trauma Strategy. The Trauma CC is seeking nominations for a new TAB Chair.

SharePoint Update

Changes to SharePoint are coming!

In September 2020, the Defense Health Agency (DHA) will decommission Bureau of Medicine & Surgery (BUMED) CAC-holder SharePoint URLs (ES.MED.NAVY.MIL/BUMED), so there will no longer be different SharePoint URLs for BUMED and non-BUMED CAC-holders.
