ONLINE APPLICATION GUIDANCE

- To Access the online site, first request a Single Sign On (SSO) account at https://apps.usuhs.edu/account-registration/
 - If you receive an error message e-mail **sakaihelp@usuhs.edu**.
- Fellows in GME training may apply for Instructor appointments, and staff physicians for Assistant Professor.
- Staff physicians with prior or current faculty appointments from other institutions should discuss their USU
 appointment with the department Chair at USU

Faculty Appointment Tidbits

- ** Have you graduated from a Fellowship? Were you appointed as an "Instructor"? If so, you can go back into the online system and submit a new application for your PROMOTION to Assistant Professor. Make sure to submit an updated CV showing completion of your training.
- **Did you know that 2021 is a reappointment cycle? All Faculty will be receiving **email notifications** in the summer of 2021 with their reappointment letter to sign and return to confirm their continued appointment. If you think your email has changed since 2018, reach out to Human Resources (CHR) with your current information by sending a quick e-mail to facultyupdate@usuhs.edu. More information will be coming in the Winter Newsletter.
- ** What is Professional Service? This is a grouping of academic work that falls into the Scholarship of Application. All Faculty must have some work in this area of scholarship to be academically promoted. This would include committees, working groups, tiger teams, and review groups. It also can include your work as a journal peer reviewer, editor, or work on conference planning committees. It can take months to years to be appointed on committees. It takes planning to get opportunities that align with your personal goals, time availability, and coordination with your direct supervisor.

Faculty Development Self-Service Site

The new Faculty Development Self-Service Site (SSS) https://fac-dev.usuhs.edu has been running for several months. Your attendance record from the previous site has been transferred to the new site. Many people are using the site and asking questions.

ACCESS: The new site is accessed via a USU Single Sign On (SSO) account. (If you were stationed at USU before, received your faculty appointment online, or have accessed our SAKAI learning management system, you likely already have an SSO account)

- 1. If you have an account, log in and make sure your user name and password still work
- 2. If your login doesn't work, or you do not know if you have an SSO account, email sakaihelp@usuhs.edu
- 3. If you do not have an SSO account, apply for one from a CAC-based computer at https://apps.usuhs.edu/account-registration/. Add jessica.servey@usuhs.edu or thomas.mcfate.ctr@usuhs.edu as the "Approving POC email.

The site allows you to:

- a) Register for sessions
- b) Withdraw from sessions
- See upcoming sessions with locations. If something is offered virtually it is indicated by the "room" location
- d) Track your own progress toward certificates
- e) Download your Fac Dev transcript
- f) Retrieve class materials from sessions you have attended, even after the session
- g) Look at old newsletters
- h) Check out the <u>Information</u> tab. Send any ideas to <u>jessica.servey@usuhs.edu</u> for other items faculty may find useful on this tab.

Did you know there is a new Advanced Teaching Certificate?

For Faculty who have already earned their 30-hour Teaching Certificate, and are looking for more opportunities to improve their education knowledge and skills, we wanted to recognize their strong commitment to improvement with the Advanced Teaching certificate. It requires 30 additional hours of synchronous learning sessions in the "Teaching" track, plus 3 "peer observations" of their teaching by trained faculty, and 1 "written reflection" on an educational session they taught where they provide thoughtful insights into what worked and what didn't.
