SUBJECT: Candidates for Program Director of the San Antonio Uniformed Services Health Education Consortium Pulmonary Critical Care Fellowship Program

- 1. In accordance with San Antonio Uniformed Services Health Education Consortium (SAUSHEC) bylaws, I am pleased to announce to the three military medical services a search for a new program director (PD) for the SAUSHEC Pulmonary Critical Care Fellowship Program, which is an internal medicine subspecialty fellowship.
- 2. We request this position be announced to interested Pulmonary Critical Care physicians with requisite specialty expertise and documented educational and administrative experience acceptable to the Accreditation Council of Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) Review Committee. Applicant experience should include subspecialty and administrative experience and at least three years as an active faculty member in an ACGME accredited internal medicine residency or pulmonary disease or critical care medicine fellowship. Applicants must have current certification in the subspecialty for which they are the program director by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM) or by the American Osteopathic Board of Internal Medicine (AOBIM) or specialty qualifications that are acceptable to the Review Committee. The Review Committee only accepts current ABIM or AOBIM certification in pulmonary disease or critical care medicine. Exceptions to these requirements will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- 3. The selectee must be available to be assigned to the Navy Medicine Training Support Center, JBSA Fort Sam Houston, TX by 30 Jun 2021 (exceptions to the report date will be individually considered).
- 4. Please submit electronic applications of qualified candidates, with your endorsement, to SAUSHEC Institutional Coordinator Mrs. Jeri Garrison not later than 26 Mar 2021. Each candidate's package should include:
 - a. Curriculum vitae (with email address and contact phone number)
 - b. Letter of Intent
 - c. Current copy of Officer Data Card
 - d. Brief statement of endorsement of eligibility from the Specialty Leader/Consultant
- 5. Applications will be reviewed by a Selection Committee and the final selectee will be approved by the SAUSHEC Command Council.
