Register now to take part in an unparalleled opportunity to expand your leadership and management skillsets. This six-day program provides a robust curriculum consisting of inter-related modules that emphasize learning through web-based course pre-work, classroom lectures, and hands-on small team case study exercises based on real-world MHS scenarios. MedXellence prepares you to lead by immersing you in an educational experience that is based on complexity theory, healthcare policy, MHS finance, strategic vision, healthcare quality/legal/privacy, patient safety, patient-centeredness, population health, performance process, integrated resourcing, knowledge tools and systems, performance improvement, strategic communication, group dynamics, and public and media relations.

The course is delivered five times a year at various locations and is free of charge (travel and per diem expenses are the responsibility of the student's organization). It is open to physicians, physician assistants, dentists, nurses, nurse practitioners, pharmacists, psychologists, health care executives, case managers, and other health care professionals. Upon completion of the course, participants can receive up to 40 hours of continuing education credit.
