Director, Healthcare Simulation and Bioskills Training Center Naval Medical Center Portsmouth

The Director of the Healthcare Simulation and Bioskills Training Center at the Naval Medical Center Portsmouth (NMCP) leads a high-impact department within the Directorate for Professional Education that uses state of the art medical simulation equipment and interactive methods to educate a large variety of learners. The department partners with multiple entities inside and outside the command to support all thirteen of NMCP's Graduate Medical Education (GME) programs, advance the command's readiness and training mission, and improve patient safety and quality of care throughout Navy Medicine. The department plays a prominent role in relations between NMCP and the fleet and other partners.

The director oversees a staff of 19 full-time active duty, contract, and government employees, and the overall operation of the center. The director develops the strategic plan for the center and manages the sophisticated equipment and other resources within the department. He or she ensures compliance with all published requirements by educational societies, and fulfills accreditation requirements as mandated by national accrediting bodies.

The incumbent reports directly to the Director, Professional Education. The position is open to senior O-4 to O-6 of any corps or military service. The selectee must devote at least 0.5 Full-Time Equivalents to the administration and oversight of the department.

The preferred candidate will have the following attributes:

- 1. Record of superior leadership performance;
- 2. Knowledge of simulation services, technologies, and applications including demonstration of advanced qualification in simulation;
- 3. History of pursuit of educational and/or scholarly activities involving simulation;
- 4. Knowledge of principles and methods for adult learning and curriculum design;
- 5. Outstanding communication, organizational, interpersonal, and collaborative skills;
- 6. Deployment or other operational experience.

Interested candidates should notify the current director of his or her intent to apply by 25AUG23. Applicants not currently assigned to NMCP must provide documentation validating his or her availability for assignment to NMCP and arrival onboard no later than **September 2023**. Applicants must submit a complete package including CV, BIO, letter of intent, last three FITREPS, and the Society for Simulation in Healthcare biosketch via email no later than **01SEP2023**.
