NEW ANONYMOUS FACULTY LISTENING POST

The Office of Faculty Affairs launched an anonymous post intended to provide a safe and confidential venue to report incidents or concerns involving bias, abuse, hostility, unprofessional behavior, and noninclusive experiences. This can also be used for any faculty concerns about processes, and suggestions are appreciated as well. Note: You can choose to remain anonymous; no information will be collected about you. You may also choose to identify yourself, and if so, agree to follow-up contact regarding your report. Email address update guidance: USU connections with National Faculty

Email migration to "health.mil" has caused some issues with accounts here at USU. Additionally, many faculty have other military emails that are not "health.mil". At the University, we do not get any updates from the uniformed services and rely on faculty to tell us when contact info has changed. We are working to streamline this process for faculty not located or assigned directly to USU with a USU email. Make any corrections to your contact info at this google link. Update from the Office of Medical Education

Student updates:

- Class 2028 are completing military training and headed to USU to have orientation in August.
- Class 2027 has completed 5 modules and headed into their summer experience.
- Class 2026 is in their fifth round of their core clerkship year.

Faculty Appointment and Promotion Tidbits

Who is eligible for a faculty appointment?

- Anyone teaching USU medical students or graduate students (Residents are not eligible)
- Clinical fellows (in fellowship training) can be Instructors or Assistant Professors
- Non-physicians teaching medical students can be Instructors
- "Teaching Fellow" is not an official academic appointment in the School of Medicine

REAPPOINTMENTS/INACTIVATIONS

Like all Schools of Medicine, USUHS requires faculty to periodically sign a "reappointment" letter to attest to their continued commitment to the school's mission. USU has a 3-year appointment cycle for those faculty on the tenure-ineligible track (the majority of faculty and ALL faculty of the uniformed services).

Starting in June these reappointment letters were sent to each faculty member from the following email address: facultyreappointment@usuhs.edu. Faculty need to sign that letter and return within 60 days or be automatically inactivated. This letter can be pen signed and scanned and emailed, or electronically signed and emailed.

As of 8 July 2024, 18 of the 20 departments have been sent letter. The last two are Radiology and Surgery. If you think you should have received a reappointment letter and have not, please email jessica.servey@usuhs.edu as we will reach out to faculty with returned emails.

***Faculty should keep this letter as their official appointment letter for personal future use. ***

Inactivations: This was the first academic year this process was electronic. Faculty would have received an email message (as long as you keep your email updated). If there is any question, reach back to the Chair of the Department or jessica.servey@usuhs.edu.

The Faculty Development Program has 2 NEW CERTIFICATES!

Faculty have asked for more offerings and more ways to demonstrate professional growth. In response we launched the <u>TECHNOLOGY CERTIFICATE</u> in October 2023. There are offerings at site visits and USU, and we have been adding virtually for this new certificate.

REQUIREMENTS:

- a) 30 hours of synchronous instruction with required sessions noted in the self-service site.
- b) Reflection of a <u>new use</u> of technology, or adaptation of prior content updated with technology, reflecting on what went well and not, noting personal use of technology and barriers to be sent to <u>som.facdev@usuhs.edu</u>.

The <u>SIMULATION CERTIFICATE</u> recently started in March 2024. We will be adding new sessions over the year. REQUIREMENTS:

- a) 24 hours of synchronous instruction with required sessions noted in the self-service site.
- b) One peer observation of a debriefing done by one of our trained peer observers.
